the crisis.**





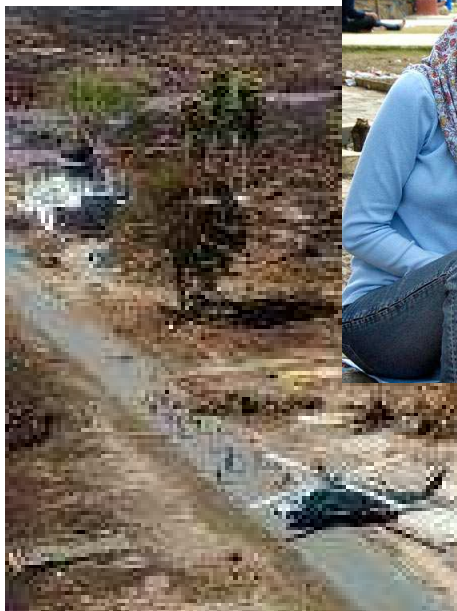
